From the Pastor

Jesus withdrew with his disciples to the lake, and a large crowd from Galilee followed. Mark 3:7

I like to think of Jesus as an introvert. I can relate to that. He often withdrew from the crowd that He found surrounding Him. I get Claustrophobic when I'm hemmed in by a crowd and I feel compelled to escape. I can't help but wonder if that was a small part of the reason Jesus withdrew. He needed to escape.

Of course, the writers of the Gospel never allude to that; or do they? They tell us Jesus withdrew to pray or teach something to the disciples. All good. 
