### **What happens at an "Interfaith Dinner Dialogue"?**

Gathering in homes of volunteer hosts who offer a meal and hospitality, participants of many and different faiths engage in groups of eight to ten in relaxed, friendly, and facilitated conversation.

"This year's goal," according to Rajinder Bains, chair of the planning committee, "is to bring together 200 participants, 70 more than last year, helping each other to gain deeper appreciation for both our uniqueness and our similarities."

### **Who are the participants?**

People of any faith or spiritual tradition - and also those who do not identify with any particular tradition - are welcome to participate, as each person in conversation respects the dignity of others and seeks to understanding among us.

Rajinder Bains characterizes the program this way: "The Dinner Dialogues are not a way of promoting our faith, or defending our faith, or even about comparing faiths, but an opportunity to deepen respect for others as we learn how each of our faiths has been a source of guidance and inspiration."
