

Jesus Loved Parties



As I was reading John chapter 2, it dawned on me that the wedding at Cana was the first event that Jesus shared with his disciples. I wonder how many leaders, spend time gathering their followers for the mission of transforming the world and defeating evil and the first thing they do is say," let's go to a party."

Cana was close to Nazareth, where Jesus lived. It was about a two hour walk, or an hour and ¾ on a fast donkey. It is likely that Joseph and Mary had friends or family there. These weddings were sometime week long affairs and usually the whole (little) town was invited. The fact that Jesus was invited is not odd, but it might have been a bit unusual that he brought these twelve other guys with him. In any case, people loved having Jesus around, and he loved being around people. In fact he loved people so much that he gave his life for them. (John 3:16)

Bob Kaylor, senior editor for "Homiletics", a magazine written for preachers by preachers, tells about going to parties which are largely secular affairs. When people find out he is a preacher, he usually gets one of the following responses: "I haven't been to church for along tie, because....." He says that he has done several confessions next to the bean dip. The second response is, "I don't like organized religion". To this he says, "Oh, you would like our church it is very unorganized".

In the long run, loving people is not about elaborate organizations, or newsletters, or bulletins, or business meetings, or any of the numerous other time takers that occupy our "religious lives". It is really about the new wine o the Holy Spirit that Jesus radiated everywhere he went. It is about taking time to pray with an inmate at the county jail, or laying a healing hand on the shoulder of a depressed or grieving person. All of us are impacted in some way by the tension in the Middle East, and how it tends to spill over into places like the Boston Marathon and the nightly news. People are hurting because the future seems clouded and threats and danger abound. Yet it was in this very context that Jesus did his ministry. He taught the ways of peace. He offered himself as the "Way". He gave the Holy Spirit as the continued presence of his Peace (John 14) He was heralded as the "Prince of Peace". (Isaiah 9) The world needs believers in Christ to know the truth and be the truth.

In 1963, I had the joy of traveling to Beirut, Lebanon. With a tour made up of youth and older people. We spent a week at the Baptist World Alliance in the Sportive Citee. The people there were gracious and kind and eager to have us there. Many were Islamic and yet welcomed us to their beautiful city. It saddens me to see it made into a war zone. I urge you to pray for peace in that land and in the other affected areas.

Jesus knew that life was not a party. Neither are we to ignore the evil that destroys the goodness of life. Whether it is the disaster of a tsunami or cancer, or the misguided sinful war mentality which dogs our history, we are called to stand in the harmony of Christ's new wine of the Spirit. We are called to be people of truth and healing.

Let us not lose sight of the call which Christ makes to us to go into all the world, the preach, teach, and baptize in his name and make disciples of all nations. (Matthew 28) We dare not lose sight of this amidst towering organizations and entangled arguments. Jesus said, simply, "Follow me". Heaven is waiting to throw a party in honor of those who do.
