#### From the Pastor

"...for you are all one in Christ Jesus..." Galatians 3:28

For the past few weeks, we have been looking at Paul's Letter to the Galatians. I attended a seminar once on Paul and his letters. It really didn't affect my negative attitude I've held toward Paul. But for some reason, the ancient scholars who included the thirteen letters of Paul in the New Testament, felt his words were important regardless of my opinion. I have always found him confusing. In some letters he praises the leadership and ministry of women in the young church and then in other places he writes that women should keep quiet and let the men do the preaching. And there is the favorite verse of many of the anti-women in leadership group that love to take the verse out of context found in Ephesians 5 telling women they are to submit and obey their husband in everything.

Ephesians 5 needs to be read entirely to understand what Paul is actually talking about. I actually preached on that verse once and said to the men who might be considering making their wives submit to them. "good luck with that!" because I know their wives – not the submissive types. (Oh, by the way, my husband was one of the men listening. He already knew how submissive I could be.)

You might be a person that has always respected what Paul wrote. As for myself, I'm beginning to learn that there is value in what he tries to convey. I am living proof that you can teach an old dog new tricks.
