

It's that time of year again!!!! The leaves are falling as well as the temperatures so the Board of Trustees want to announce the Fall cleanup date so you can mark your calendar; Saturday October 25th 2014 at 9 am. We will be not only cleaning up on the outside but on the inside as well.

We would really like to reach out to everyone in the congregation to get a group of more than 6 or 7 people. There is a lot to be done; organizing, cleaning, dusting, making sure things are where they belong. In the past we have heard comments about "paying someone to clean" so we should not have to, or I am busy on that day, or I do not have much to offer as far as cleaning. We do pay to have BASIC cleaning done weekly, but as you know in your own home there is always a bit of deeper organization and cleaning to be done a few times a year. We want to be proud of our church home, so it is our responsibility to care for it. If your schedule does not meet our date, feel free to come on your own schedule and let us know what you would like to tackle and when (classrooms, library, narthex, music room, nursery, bathrooms, meditation room, kitchen, vard work, dusting) any organization skills can be used. 
Family Fun Day
