Mission Project



The Paston's Corner



I don't know about you but I have come to the conclusion that the "Lazy, hazy days of summer" is a myth we dream about. For one thing, it is too short. It's rarely lazy but does get hazy on a hot, muggy day.

So here we are, Labor Day weekend. It's September and time to get moving. I've been serving this congregation for 10 months. It hardly seems possible. I have enjoyed every minute. I've spent some time getting acquainted with as many of you as I could and with how you function as a church family. I'm delighted that you get along well with other and love and care for each other. All families have their disagreements and I have heard some grumbling on occasion but for the most part this is a close-knit family.

I have also seen some stubbornness. We can't always do things the same way they have always been done. This has happened partly because the way things have always been done were done by people who are no longer active in our church. We need to look at what has been done; what has been done well and how we can continue to do what needs to be done while still reaching those that need to know Jesus.

One of the responsibilities of an Interim Pastor is to help the church prepare for the next called/settled pastor. A mission/ministry should be in place and running smoothly when that person arrives so they don't have to start at step one. The mission/ministry of the church should ideally be exactly that not the mission/ministry of the pastor. For that to happen the congregation needs to look at their strengths and weaknesses. And then determine what ministry opportunities they can successfully accomplish. That is the main reason the search committee has asked for comments related to people and events that shaped the ministry and the congregation thus far. We need to dig deeper. Why is it that the building sits in the center of the village but the membership live outside the center of the village? (I am using membership as a representative of all regular attendees not the card holding duly baptized members.) My guess would be that at one time, probably when it was built, the church attracted people in the surrounding community. As time went on people moved to the "suburbs" of Central Square. So a weakness I see is the lack of people from the surrounding community. Now, I know times have changed and people don't attend church like they used too. But what can we learn from this? People in our surroundings need to hear the message. How do we deliver it to them? This is what we need to determine. If we sit by and do nothing there is the serious danger of becoming a group of people looking out for themselves and "their" church and not doing what they have been called to do. The chances are very good that whatever we do will not put people in the pews on Sunday morning but we will have done what Jesus told us to do and He will bless our efforts.

For the next few months, I hope to be able to work among you to help figure it all out so when you find that person you are looking for, you will be already doing what you need to be doing. God is faithful. We believe this. We know this. We also know He has a plan and a ministry for us to do.
